Mr. Bruce Leroy Adams, age 81 of Plano, Texas passed away on December 4, 2005 in Plano. He was born on January 15, 1924 in Ashland, Kentucky to Charles and Anna (Kitchens) Adams. Mr. Adams is survived by his wife, Sunny Adams of Plano, Texas; son, John Adams of Denver, Colorado; daughter, Janet Briscoe and husband, Bill of Plano, Texas; and grandchildren, Lisa and Laurie Briscoe both of Plano, Texas. His parents preceded him in death. A graveside service will be held at 11:00 AM, Tuesday, December 6, 2005 at DFW National Cemetery in Dallas, TX. Visitation will be from 7:00 PM until 9:00 PM at Turrentine-Jackson-Morrow Funeral Home.
