Callie Faye Bollin of Plano, Texas passed away September 1, 2021 at the age of 78. She was born on February 22, 1943 to Elliott Stevens and Eddie Ree (Smith) in McKinney, Texas. Callie was a graduate of the historic E. S. Doty School in McKinney which closed in 1966. She participated in the band and played the drums.
