October 9, 1925 - February 28, 2019

Hanse Mason Hamilton, Jr. of Dallas, Texas passed away on February 28, 2019 in McKinney, Texas at the age of 93. He was born on October 9, 1925 to Hanse and Gladys (Brown) Hamilton in Waco, Texas. Hanse proudly served his country in the United States Marine Corps during World War II and was wounded on Iwo Jima for which he was awarded the Purple Heart. On February 24, 1946, he married Juanita Elam in Dallas, Texas. He is a graduate of Southern Methodist University and earned bachelor's degree in accounting and became a Certified Public Accountant. He worked for the Internal Revenue Service for 33 years until his retirement. Hanse was an active member of the Collin County Marine Corps League.
