Hershelle Glenn Cain, age 94, passed away peacefully on December 9, 2011 at Emeritus Assisted Living in McKinney, Texas with Margaret, his wife of 73 years, by his side. Glenn was born in Allen, Texas on February 4, 1917 to Cletus Andrew Cain and Nell Barnum Cain. He graduated from Allen High School in 1935 and had a long career in automotive parts sales and insurance sales. He was a devoted husband, father and grandfather and beloved by his family. He had a strong work ethic that he passed along to those around him. He especially liked teaching his sons to play baseball, to water ski and how to take care of just about anything.
