Veona "Jeanette" (Woods) Clifton, 78, of Farmersville, TX, passed away unexpectedly on July 31, 2018. She was born July 21, 1940 in Blanco, Texas to William Nelson and Veoma Nell (Calentine) Woods. She married the love of her life, Bobbie Frank Clifton, on her 16th birthday, July 21, 1956 in Carlsbad, NM, and they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary two months before Bob lost his battle to cancer on September 23, 2006.
