*November 18, 1944 - June 9, 2020*

Michael Andries of McKinney, Texas passed away June 9, 2020 at the age of 75. He was born on November 18, 1944 to Albert Vincent Andries and Ruby (Meyers) Andries in DeQuincy, Louisiana. Michael was a 1963 graduate of Holy Savior Menard Catholic School in Alexandria, Louisiana. He attended Louisiana State University and Northwestern State University before joining the United States Marine Corps in May of 1966. Michael served his country proudly in Khe Sanh, Vietnam during the Tet Offensive of 1968 as a Corporal for United States Marine Corps. After he was discharged from duty, Michael and Karen married in Prescott, Arizona. They lived in Louisiana for a short time before moving to California. Together, he and Karen raised their two daughters in California before settling in Texas in 1990. After retirement, he and Karen bought a cattle farm in Blue Ridge, Texas. Michael enjoyed tending the farm for several years before his health declined. Being at home, he valued spending time with his beloved wife, Karen and dogs, Winston and Hilts. During their time together, Michael and Karen traveled to numerous countries with family and friends. He loved watching Fox News. Michael most loved making delicious meals for his family and keeping his lawn pretty for all to see.

Michael is survived by his beloved wife, Karen Parson Andries; daughters, Ashley Andries and wife, Laura of McKinney, Texas and Danielle Andries, all of McKinney, Texas; brothers and sisters, Ronnie, Kala, Alice, Alan, Lynn, Candace, and Terry; numerous nieces, nephews, family and friends who loved him dearly.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Albert and Ruby Andries; and brother, Donald Andries.
