Robert Christopher Anderson "Topher" of McKinney, Texas passed away at home on Wednesday, March 25, 2020 of pancreatic cancer. He was born on January 10, 1972 in Niskayuna, New York. He was 48.

He was a graduate of Heritage High School, Littleton, Colorado. He received degrees from The University of Kansas with a Bachelor of Science in Business and Texas Christian University with a Master of Business Administration.
