



## Scott Joseph Bliven

*June 4, 1969 - August 22, 2020*

Scott Joseph Bliven of McKinney, Texas passed away August 22, 2020, at the age of 51, and was welcomed into the embrace of our Heavenly Father. He was born on June 4, 1969 to Fred "Buddy" Allyn Bliven and Helen Frances [Terminesi] Bliven in New London, Connecticut. Scott grew up in Waterford, Connecticut and was a 1987 graduate of Waterford High School. He earned his bachelor's degree in Education from Central Connecticut State in New Britain, Connecticut. Scott taught and worked in medical sales throughout his life. Most recently, he worked as a structural analyst in the foundation inspection industry. Scott loved to laugh, enjoyed music and sports. Scott was preceded in death by his father, Fred Bliven.

A funeral service will be held at 2:00 p.m., Friday, September 4, 2020 Turrentine-Jackson-Morrow Funeral Home Chapel, 2525 Central Expressway North, Allen, Texas. The service will also be live streamed on the Turrentine-Jackson-Morrow Facebook page and a recorded video will be available following the funeral service on Scott's obituary page.
