Sidney Lynn Biggs, devoted father and granddad, passed away January 31, 2012 at the Veteran's Hospital in Dallas, Texas, after a lengthy illness. Lynn was born in Celina, Texas, on March 25, 1932, to Clarence and Grace Vick Biggs. He was a member of the Church of Christ. He graduated from Celina High School in 1950.
