Vergie Marie Bridges of Allen, Texas passed away on May 13, 2019 at the age of 89. She was born on October 15, 1929 to Clyde Vernon "C.V." and Sarah (Holcomb) Elliott in Tuttle, Oklahoma. Vergie grew up in Mustang, Oklahoma where she was a 1947 graduate of Mustang High School. After graduation, she moved to Lawton, Oklahoma, where she met her husband, Eddie Ollen Bridges. They were married on April 22, 1950 in Lawton, Oklahoma; he preceded her in death on June 4, 2000. Over the years, the family moved over 70 times but she always made it feel like home.
